## What do I need to do to correct this error?

Answer:

This error is due to a limit on the number of source lines the Java compiler allows in a single block.Â

Compile with -sns=1000 to set the maximum at 1000 lines per COBOL paragraph. If that doesn'; twork then try lower values. For best performance use the highest number that works. And optimally, only use the -sns option when compiling programs that require it.
