

Is there any equivalent to COPY RESOURCE?

Question:

I got the following compiler warning. Is there any equivalent for the COPY RESOURCE functionality?

```
--W: Directive ignored: COPY RESOURCE; file = smSWLOGON.CO, line = 1783, col
```

Answer:

Prior to version 2022R1, the isCOBOL compiler ignores the COPY RESOURCE statement to avoid creating a .jar file for each program.

We suggest putting the resource files (.bmp for example) in the same folder as the .class files. You can create a myapplication.jar file that contains all .class and resource files.

Version 2022R1 and later supports the COPY RESOURCE syntax, and will include the bitmaps and fonts in your class, so there is no need to provide them separately.
