

Is there any way to direct the output from the “Print Screen” keyboard key directly to a printer?

The ';PrintScreen'; key is directly handled by the OS and cannot be referenced in COBOL.

In that case you can develop an isCOBOL program that could be run as hotkey program. Example: `iscobol.hot_key.printscreen=7` The isCOBOL program PRINTSCREEN will be executed pressing F7 (by default F7 returns exception-value 7).

You can also consider to create a push-button "PrintScreen" in your GUI interface with a particular exception(101) associated to the `iscobol.hot_key.printscreen=101`. This program should call "W\$CAPTURE" routine (see installed sample under `isCOBOLxxx/sample/issamples-routines/WCAPTURE.cbl`, or the sample written in the isCOBOL documentation at the W\$CAPTURE description) to store an image file on disk.

So you can choose the printer and print the image file calling "WIN\$PRINTER" routine with different op-codes like WINPRINT-SETUP, WINPRINT-PRINT-BITMAP (see installed sample under `isCOBOLxxx/sample/issamples/s-routines/WINPRINTER.cbl`)
